## Child Tax Credit

### Every dollar counts when raising thriving kids

Eligible families may receive a **Child Tax Credit of up to \$1,750** for each qualifying child under the age of 18.

Last year, Minnesota families like yours received nearly **\$582 million in Child Tax Credits**, benefiting close to **462,000 children**, with the resources needed for things like food, diapers, clothing, and other necessities.

**To claim the Child Tax Credit, you must file your Minnesota state income tax forms.** The Child Tax Credit can reduce the amount of income taxes you pay and you may receive a refund even if you don't owe taxes on your income from the past year.

Your family may qualify for \$1,750 per child if your income is up to \$37,910 (married) or \$31,950 (others). Families with incomes above these amounts may qualify for a smaller credit (see *table for CTC income limits*).
